



2009 PINOT NOIR ROSELLA'S VINEYARD "777"

A rare single clone, single vineyard bottling, the 2009 Rosella's Vineyard Pinot Noir "777" is both intense and appealing with floral, exotic spice aromas and a silky textured palate of dark berry fruit. The "777" Dijon clone is a specific variety within the Pinot Noir family originally from Burgundy's Morey St. Denis region in France.
