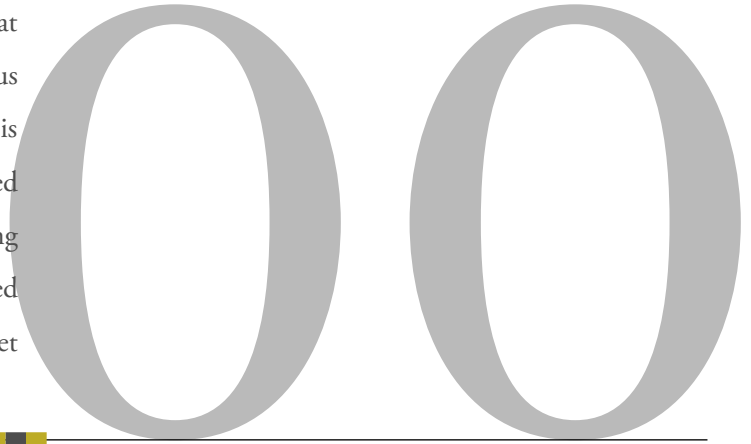


2000 MERLOT STAGECOACH VINEYARD

Carved out of rocky, red volcanic soil similar to the earth up at Oakville Ranch, Stagecoach Vineyard gives us the rich, voluminous & decadent characteristics of mountain grown fruit. This wine is proof positive that we will never hang our hats on a wimpy, diluted and flavorless Merlot. Expect deep, rich earth and tobacco notes along with flavors of sweet blackberry, currant and cocoa nicely bundled and balanced on the palate with a lingering campfire finish of sweet oak and fruit.
