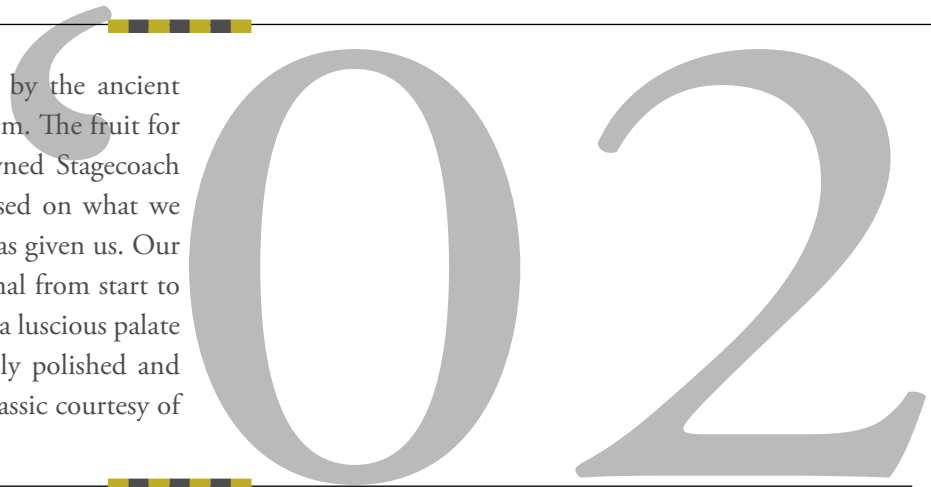


THE ORACLE

The Oracle is a Bordeaux-style blend inspired by the ancient Greek Oracle, the center of prophecy and wisdom. The fruit for this wine is sourced from Napa Valley's renowned Stagecoach Vineyard, and the blend changes each year based on what we believe makes the best wine from what nature has given us. Our sophomore effort, the 2002 vintage, is sensational from start to finish. Bold aromatics of black cherry and spice, a luscious palate full of cassis, cocoa and toasty oak. Impressively polished and structured with all the trademarks of a Miner classic courtesy of winemaker Gary Brookman.
