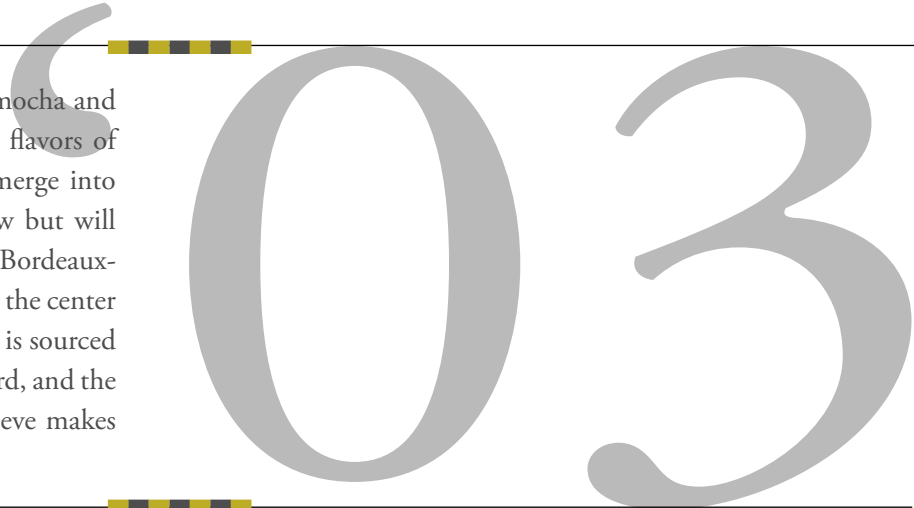


THE ORACLE

2003 NAPA VALLEY RED WINE

Distinctly deep in color with aromas of cassis, mocha and vanilla that give way to a palate full of intense flavors of black cherry, leather and spice that smoothly merge into a lush, long finish. Refined, fresh and rich now but will mature in the cellar with finesse. The Oracle is a Bordeaux-style blend inspired by the ancient Greek Oracle, the center of prophecy and wisdom. The fruit for this wine is sourced from Napa Valley's renowned Stagecoach Vineyard, and the blend changes each year based on what we believe makes the best wine from what nature has given us.

Miner Family Vineyards is a dynamic, family-owned winery tucked along the eastern hills of the Oakville appellation in the heart of Napa Valley.
