Our flagship wine, inspired by the ancient Greek Oracle, reveals flavors of spicy plum, ripe blackberry with hints of cedar backed by requisite acidity and supple, generous tannins. Made using fruit sourced from the renowned Stagecoach Vineyard, this Bordeaux style blend will drink well through 2014. The cooler 2005 vintage stands out for its ideal ripening conditions that allowed for incredible complexity, color and nuance.
