Our second bottling of Malbec is noted for its textured palate of plum and earthy-tobacco flavors. This versatile food wine has a bold acid structure and plenty of fine tannins making it a good foil for red meat and hard cheeses such as Manchego and aged Gouda. This wine will benefit from a few years in the cellar.
