2009 GRENACHE SIERRA FOOTHILLS

Sourced from the Naiggar family vineyard in the foothills of the Sierra Nevada Mountains, our Grenache has floral, spicy aromas on the nose and strawberry-raspberry flavors on the palate. Winemaker Gary Brookman recommends enjoying this lighter bodied red just below cellar temperature and within two to four years of the vintage. Grenache pairs well with a variety of dishes from paella to grilled pork tenderloin.
