Hyde Vineyards is a well-respected family venture established by Larry Hyde in 1979. Hyde became a vineyard designate Miner Chardonnay starting with the 2009 vintage. Cooled by San Pablo Bay breezes and fog, the vineyard is situated on gently rolling hills in the Carneros region.

This wine is characterized by a natural balance of crisp, fresh flavors of citrus and spiced pear laced with minerality and light toasty oak. Drink now through 2016.
