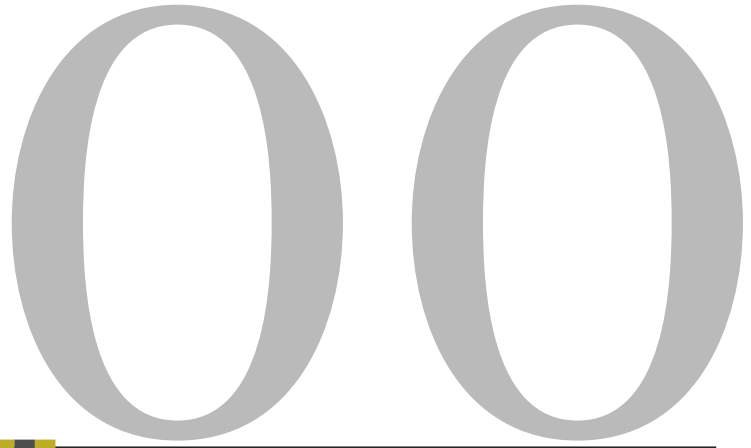


## 2000 CABERNET SAUVIGNON OAKVILLE
