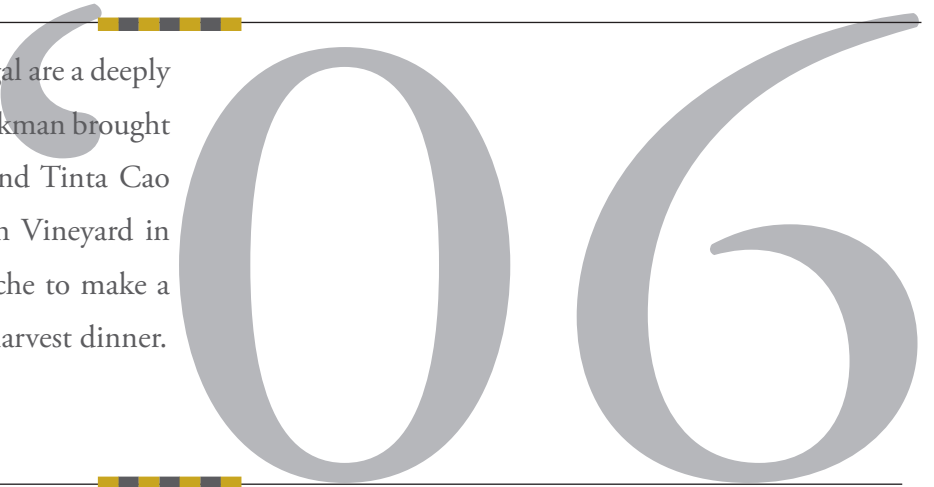


THE ENIGMA PORTUGEUSE BLEND
