



2009 CHARDONNAY GENNY'S VINEYARD

Genny's Vineyard, owned by the Garvey family, is located in the cooler Carneros region of Napa Valley and is planted to two different clones of Chardonnay - Wente and Dijon. Aromas of spiced pear lead to a plush palate of tropical fruit and mineral flavors framed in French oak. Drink through 2014. Delicious with grilled chicken or halibut.
