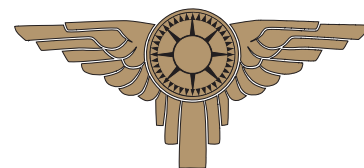


2016 GRENACHE

Sourced from the Naggiar family vineyard in the foothills of the Sierra Nevada Mountains, our Grenache has floral, spicy aromas on the nose and strawberry-raspberry flavors on the palate.

Winemaker Stacy Vogel recommends enjoying this lighter-bodied red just below cellar temperature and within two to four years of the vintage. Grenache pairs well with a variety of dishes from paella to grilled pork tenderloin.

HISTORY
