Our third release of Cabernet Franc, this limited production wine displays classic aromas of pepper spice on the nose, ripe cherry fruit and hints of mocha on the palate with enlivening acidity and finely grained tannins. Winemaker Gary Brookman suggests drinking this wine over the next 3 to 6 years (or decant and drink a bottle tonight).
