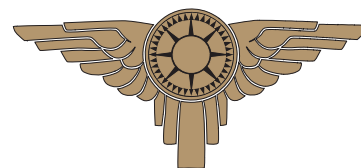

The "777" Dijon clone is a specific variety within the Pinot Noir family originally from Burgundy's Morey St. Denis region in France.
