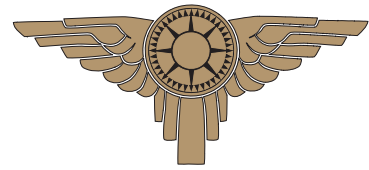

HISTORY
